How to grow Rosemary



Preparing your pot

Take one small seed tray.



Fill the tray with a sand base or Vermiculite mix you can buy from garden centres.



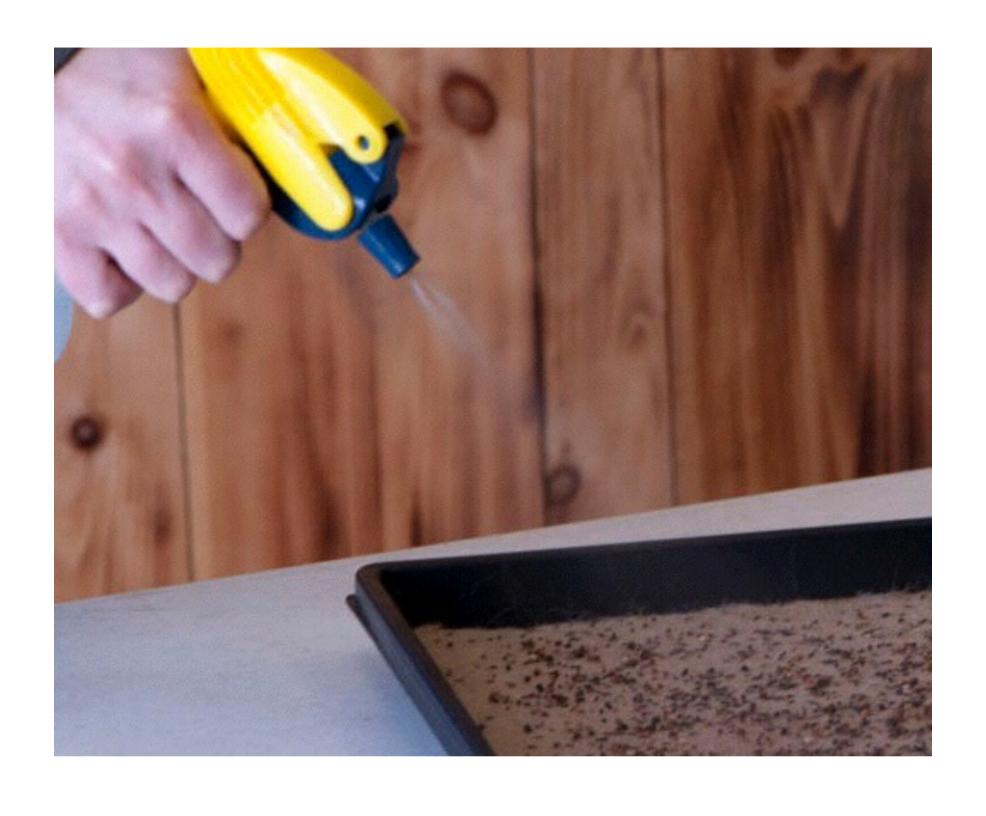
Level out the soil in the tray.







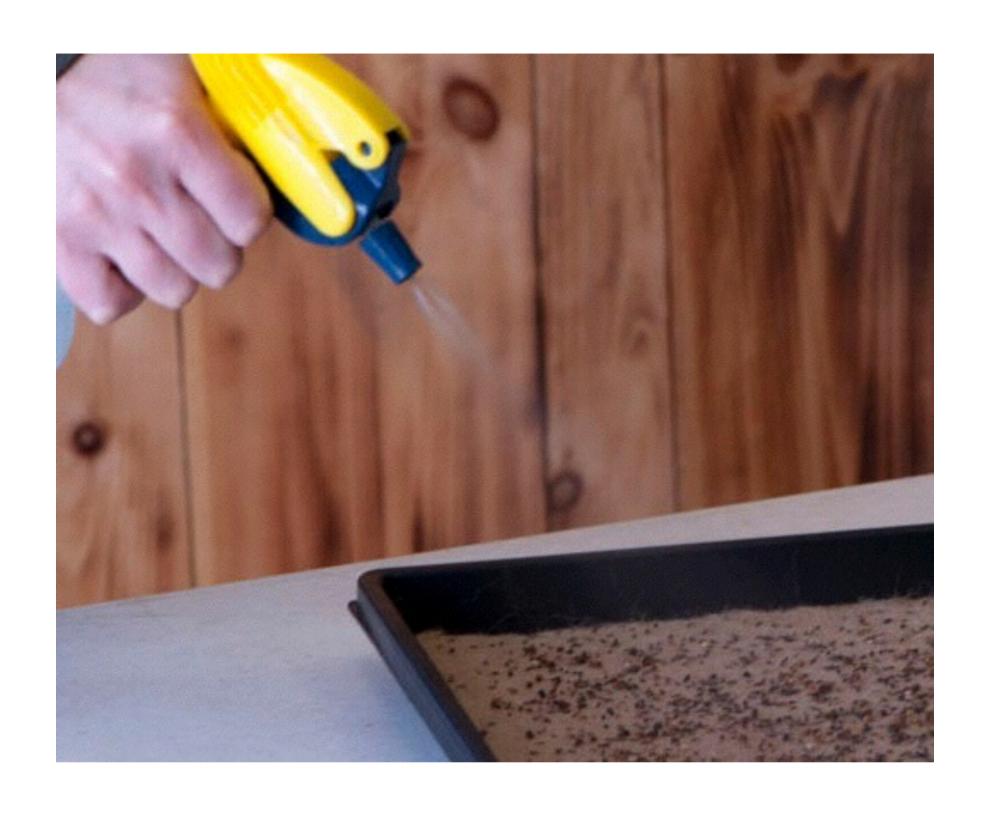
Put three or four seeds in each section.



Spray the seeds with water.



Cover seeds with more soil.



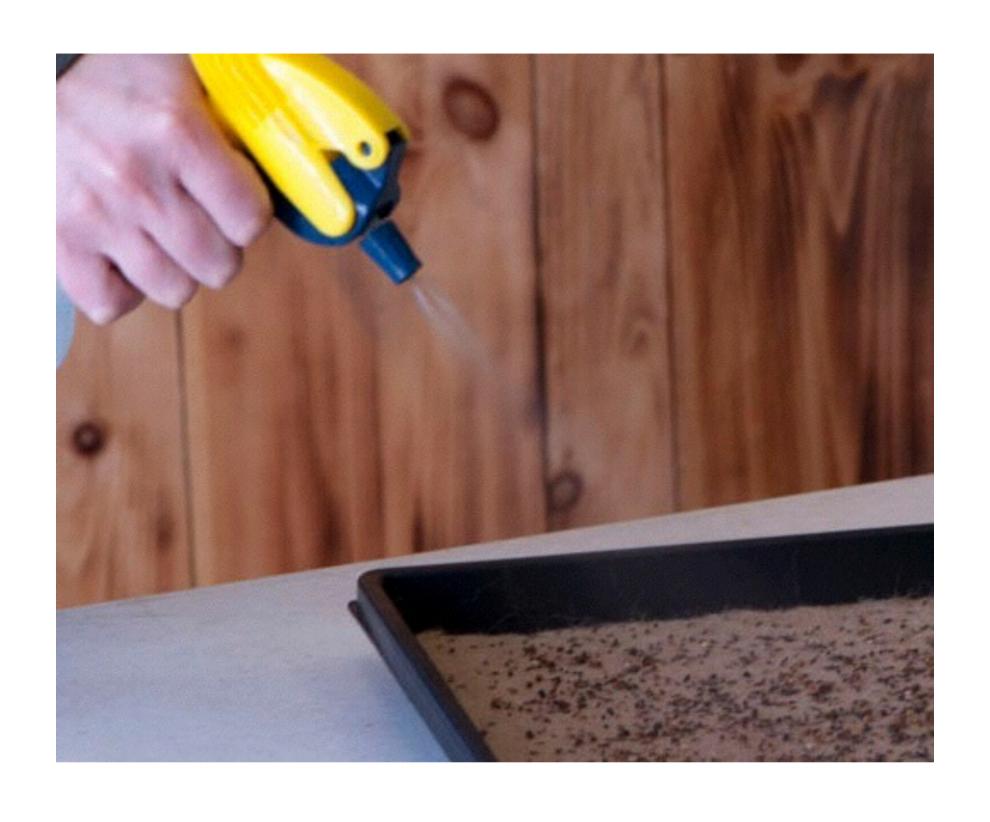
Spray again with water.



Cover the tray with a clear plastic cover.



Find a sunny location for the seeds to grow.



Use the spray bottle when you see the soil has dried out.



When the seeds have grown to at least three inches in height you can put each seedling in another pot.



When your rosemary is big enough it can be transplanted into the ground or a bigger pot.
