Preparing the ground

Before planting your spring onion seeds make sure the ground is well prepared and raked.







Using your guide line draw a line from one end of the plot to the other.




Using the corner of a hoe or rake gently create a small channel following your guide line.



Now water the channel with a small amount of water.

Your seeds are ready to be sown.





Sprinkle the seeds into the channel.

Make sure your next row of seeds is 20cm away from the first row.



Once you have completed your first line using the side of your hand gently move some soil over the seeds.



Now water your row of seeds.



Your seedlings should grow within a few weeks.



Water regularly and when the ground is dry.



Spring onions are ready to pick within 8 weeks. Simply pull from the ground.
