





or a wooden box or anything that could hold your plants. **NOTE:** It has to have holes in it.



Buy different kinds of **potting plants** to fill up your pot.



Buy some soil called **multi- purpose compost.** 



Put **strong paper** at the bottom and on the sides of your pot or box.



Put some **soil** at the bottom of your pot or box.



Put your plants in the pot or box the way you like.



**Don't forget** to take your plants out of the pots from the shop before putting them into your pot or box.



Once you are happy with the way your plants look in your pot or box, fill in any gaps between with soil.



Press the soil so that it is **firm.** 



Once your pot is ready, decide where to keep it.

NOTE: Your plants must get a lot of morning sun.



TIP: You can try putting your pot or box on a tray, then fill the tray with water regularly to feed the plants.



TIP: If a few months later any of your plants are dying, you can cut them back to help grow better.
