Pine Cone Bunnies

It's possible while you were busy in the garden last week you discovered some pinecones! We can use these to make some Easter bunnies!

What you will need:

- Pinecones
- Googly eyes
- Cotton wool or felt
- Craft glue
- Twine
- Pom poms
- Scissors

Simply stick the decorations onto the pinecones like so, to create a bunny.







Easter Wreath

What you will need:

- Paper plate
- Ribbon
- Spring/Easter themed wrapping paper
- Glue
- Scissors





Step 1

Cut out the centre of the paper plate

Step 2

Cut out egg shapes in the wrapping paper

Step 3

Glue around the paper ring in the style of a wreath

Step 4

Cut through one egg on the paper ring to loop some ribbon through so you can hang the wreath Et... Voila!

Nest Eggs

What you will need:

- Balloons
- Embroidery floss
- Fabric stiffener / liquid starch

Step 1

Soak your embroidery floss in the starchy liquid bath

Step 2

Carefully wrap your soaked embroidery floss around your balloons until they resemble a nest.

Step 3

Allow to dry for several hours (preferably ovemight). Ensure you turn them over once and allow to dry for a couple more hours.

Step 4

Once completely dry, try to gently separate the floss from the surface, then for the fun part...

Step 5

POP THE BALLOONS!

You can arrange all your eggs into a bowl, maybe glue them together to make a wreath? The choice is yours!







Paper Plate Bunnies

What you will need:

- Card Paper
- Pom Poms
- Pipe Cleaners
- Googly Eyes
- Small Paper Plates
- Glue

Method

- 1. Tie three pipe cleaners like so
- 2. Glue the pompom onto the join to create the nose
- 3. Glue the nose and whiskers onto the paper plate and let dry.





- 6. Glue to the back of the plate.
- 7. Add the googly eyes above the nose on the plate
- 8. Finish by drawing the mouth underneath the nose!





- 4. Cut ear shapes out of the white card
- 5. Cut smaller ear shapes out of the pink paper and glue ontop of the
