



Apple Collage

Apples are best for harvesting around September and October.

What you will need:

- Scraps of red paper (tissue, wrapping, junk mail etc)
- A small scrap of green paper
- Glue
- Paper plate

Method

- 1. Cover the back of the white plate with glue.
- 2. Rip the scraps of red paper up and glue onto the plate.
- 3. When the whole plate is covered, paint another layer of glue and repeat.
- 4. Cut out two leaves and a stalk from the green paper and glue to the edge of the plate.

Apple Tree Handpainting

What you will need:

- Green, red and brown paint
- Canvas (card or paper)

Method:

- 1. Using lots of hands and green paint, paint the tree.
- 2. Using your fingers, add in the apples with the red paint.
- 3. Use your hands and fingers with the brown paint to create the tree trunk.





Autumn Sticker Tree

What you will need:

- Brown paint
- Red, yellow and orange stickers
- Canvas (paper or card)

Method:

- 1. Stick your hands in the brown paint and stamp on the canvas to create the tree trunk.
- 2. When the paint is dry, use lots of the stickers to make the colourful autumn leaves.



Autumn Wreath

What you will need:

- Paper plate
- Red, yellow and orange card
- Gold pen
- Glue

Method:

- 1. Cut out lots of leaves from the red, yellow and orange card.
- 2. Use the gold pen to draw the leaf design.
- 3. Cut out the middle of the paper plate.
- 4. Glue the leaves around the edge of the paper plate to make your wreath.



Hedgehog

What you will need:

- Pencil
- Scissors
- Canvas (paper or card)
- Glue Stick
- Autumn shades of paper
- Natural materials (pinecones, leaves, conkers etc)
- Google eyes
- Black pom-poms

Method:

- 1. Get outdoors and scavenge for items that would make a great, textured hedgehog.
- 2. Draw a raindrop shape on some light coloured card, and glue horizontally onto a canvas.
- 3. Cut out leaf shapes from the autumn coloured card.
- 4. Go wild with natural materials and bring the hedgehog to life!
- 5. Layer up the leaves and natural materials.





6. Finish your hedgehog with a googly eye and fluffy pompom nose and draw on a smile.
