



Personalised Necktie

What you will need:

- A4 Card
- Hole punch
- Pencil
- Felt pens
- Scissors
- Elastic
- Decorating materials

Method:

1. Fold the A4 card in half lengthways
2. Use a pencil to draw out the tie shape
3. Keep the card folded and cut out the necktie shape to give you two matching ties.
4. Colour and decorate like your father would want
5. Punch a small hole in each tab and thread elastic through.
6. Send to your father as a gift!



Father's Day Handprint Art

What you will need:

- Canvas
- Cardstock or Construction Paper
- Paint
- Paint Brush
- Scissors
- Glue
- Black Marker



Method:

1. Paint your palm with flesh-tone paint and your fingers with the colour of your dad's hair.
2. Press down on the card or canvas to make your father's face and hair.
3. Paint your other palm with the colour your dad would wear as a shirt. Also paint most of your thumbs this colour but leave the tips as flesh-toned.
4. Paint your two middle fingers as the colour of trousers i.e. blue, black, grey.
5. Turn your hand the other way as the face and hair print and press down. Use the pictures for help.
6. Once all the paint has dried, draw a face and any other features you want.
7. Take the card and cut a fish shape into it, to make a necktie. You can decorate how you want.
8. And there you have it! Your father as a hand painting.



My Dad Rocks!

What you will need:

- A large, smooth rock from outside
- Paint
- Paintbrushes
- Wet + dry paper towels
- *Optional* – Clear Sealant

Method:

1. Clean the rock with a wet paper towel and dry
2. Use paint colours of your choosing to decorate the rock
3. Write 'My Dad Rocks!' using black paint, or add any special message of your choice.
4. When the paint has dried, write the date and your name on the back of the rock.
5. Once all dried, you can also add a top coat to make it smoother and more durable, a clear sealant will do the trick.



6. You can display your rock however you want, or give it your dad to proudly display!
