



Japan Crafts

What you will need:

- Large piece of paper
- · Black, pink and white paint
- Bubble wrap

Method:

- 1. To start, simply paint a bare tree with the black paint on your paper.
- 2. Paint the bubble wrap sporadically with pink paint.
- 3. Press down the painted side firmly on the paper.
- 4. Remove the bubble wrap and repeat all over your tree.
- 5. Take another piece of bubble wrap and paint white.
- 6. Press down on the tree to add dimension to the colours of the blossom.
- 7. Take bubble wrap away and leave to dry.








Miniature Zen Garden Sensory Craft

What you will need:

- A small box
- Sand
- Pebbles
- A fork
- Small plants and other decorations

Method:

- 1. Fill the box halfway to the rim with sand.
- 2. Use your fork to draw a pattern in the sand.
- 3. Arrange your pebbles and plants to your liking.









DIY Japanese Fan

What you will need:

- 10 craft sticks (ice lolly sticks work)
- Map pin
- Protractor
- Pencil
- Scissors

Method:

- 1. Lay the sticks out.
- 2. Puncture a hole in each using the pin.
- 3. Lay the sticks on top of each other aligning the holes.
- 4. Thread the pin through all the holes.
- 5. Twist the end of the pin around to close the holes.
- 6. Draw an arc with the protractor on some paper.
- 7. Cut out the arc.
- 8. Position the sticks evenly over the rest of the paper with the joining point at the bottom of the cut out arc.
- 9. Trace around the sticks.
- 10. Coat one side of each stick with glue.
- 11. Glue sticks within the lines you drew.
- 12. Cut out the excess paper between the sticks.
- 13. Glue the edges over and decorate how you wish. You can even cut out a decorative piece of paper the same way and stick on top of the fan. See video for more here.
