

This large detached residential property in Newport, near Telford, is located on a quiet street off the beaten track.

The home has undergone a full renovation to create supported living accommodation for eight adults with complex care needs. Inside the home will be six self-contained apartments and two further studio flats, all with their own bedroom, wet room/bathroom, kitchen/diner and lounge areas.

This specialist home will also be equipped with a craft room and other communal areas, a large garden with decked areas and a lawn.

The self-contained style of each apartment allows us to offer bespoke support for each person living here, including people with complex needs or those who are unable to share accommodation but can also accommodate adults who are more independent and looking to take that next step.
