Newly refurbished, this is a supported living home in Sutton for adults with autism spectrum condition, epilepsy, emotional needs, mental health, learning disabilities, complex needs and behaviours that may challenge. People are supported in developing individualised person-centred plans and positive behaviour support plans that promote increased choice, control over their lives and independence.

The experienced team works with families, carers and health and social care professionals to ensure that support is proactive and appropriate. A person-centred approach is tailored to each person, who are encouraged to be fully involved in all decisions regarding their care and support.

The team are available 24 hours a day to support in all aspects of daily life, from cooking, laundry, support finding employment, understanding bills and growing further independence, along with other day-to-day activities. We can also accommodate supported sleeping, and there will always be a waking night team member on hand.

A large semi-detached house with six homely bedrooms, each with en-suite facilities, people can also socialise in the communal areas, including the spacious kitchen, lounge and dining room.

The property also features a garden and a small, quiet room that people may find especially beneficial.

People are supported to take part in activities that increase independence and improve communication and social skills. This includes support in daily life, such as household tasks and meal preparation. People can also choose to seek out and explore work experience and paid work placements in order to maximise their quality of life and learn new skills.

People living here are also able to participate in regular leisure activities such as swimming, cinema trips and bowling, as the location is close to Sutton town centre and has great transport links.
