Oakview is a residential home for adults with severe learning disabilities, profound and multiple learning disabilities, restricted mobility, sight impairment and epilepsy. The home aims to support people in achieving their goals, participating in meaningful activities and becoming as independent as possible.

Oakview provides support in a person centred way, with every aspect tailored to people's unique skills, strengths and goals in mind. People are supported and motivated to lead a fulfilling lifestyle, building on important life and social skills.

Life at the home

At oakview, we prioritise supporting people to engage in a diverse range of activities. From swimming and college outings to holidays and indoor sessions like pet therapy, aroma therapy, sensory room experiences, music, and cooking sessions, actively encourage a wide variety of interests.

Our commitment to inclusivity ensures that wheelchair users receive the necessary support to participate in any chosen activity. Additionally, we're engaged in an exciting project, transforming our outdoor space into a sensory haven with carefully selected flowers and plants. This area promises enriching sensory experiences and activities, allowing everyone at oakview to connect with nature when the weather permits.

What we offer

At oakview, all bedrooms are on the ground-floor and can be decorated to people's individual tastes and needs. They all have their own en-suite wet rooms. There are communal areas, including a living room, kitchen and dining area, and a fully equipped sensory room.

The garden is fully accessible with raised planters so people can enjoy gardening and spending time in the garden. There is also a swing and patio area for barbecues and social events in the summer.
