Location:

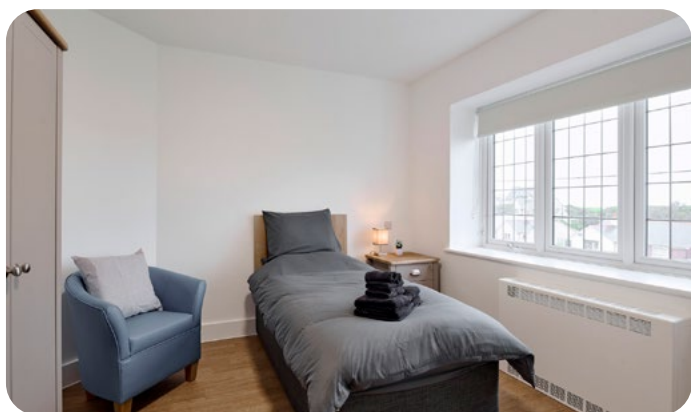
