Although they support individuals, the team also encourage group activities, and love nothing more than day trips to Western, Barry and Porthcawl.

BBQ's and annual sports day events are also a favourite here. There is a dedicated Activities Co-ordinator who is responsible for making the ideas in our monthly home meeting happen.

Co-production plays a central role — during a recent lounge redecoration project, the people we support chose the new furniture for the space. They also put forward activities for the new room, including movie nights, games and cards, kebabs and a face mask and film night, all of which are now on the calendar!

The home is located in Newport and has excellent transport links, including the nearby bus and train stations that are regularly used for popping to town or for day trips to Barry and Porthcawl.
