Popular activities for the people we support at Newton House include movie nights, trips to the local pub, beach days, and trip's theme parks and zoos. Newton House is perfectly located for these trips, with The New Forest, Boscombe, Marwell Zoo and Legoland all within easy reach. Other areas of interest include swimming, horse riding, train trips and cinema visits.

The home also welcomes externally run activities, including modern music therapy, Zoolab and wildlife bird sessions. Newbury has a lovely mix of local history, green spaces and community activities, with places such as Northcroft Park for walks, picnics and time outdoors. People can also enjoy visits to The Watermill Theatre, the Corn Exchange, Newbury Racecourse, Donnington Castle, the Kennet and Avon Canal and The Living Rainforest.
