Birmingham Road is in the market town of West Bromwich, with community inclusion at the heart of everyday life. The home is within easy reach of West Bromwich High Street, offering access to shops, cafés, pharmacies and local dining options, helping people feel connected and involved in their community.

Birmingham city centre is also close by, with popular destinations such as the Bullring Shopping Centre, Cadbury World and Birmingham Botanical Gardens.
