Achieve together support a number of people with complex epilepsy syndromes including Lennox-Gastaut, Dravet Syndrome, Retts Syndrome and also people with non-epileptic seizures – our skillset is strong; therefore, we are able to guide and support teams to provide personalised support to assist each person to live a happy, healthy and meaningful life, managing their epilepsy well.
