I choose who I live with.



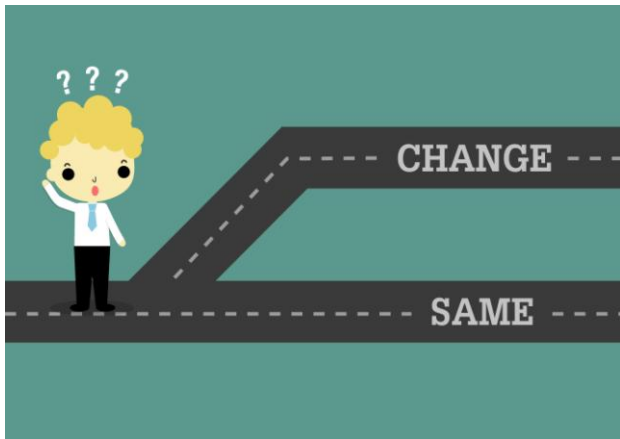
**I have my own home

changes in my life.**



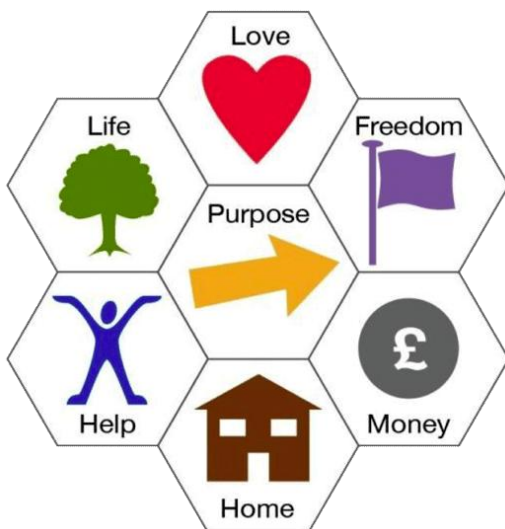
**I choose how to be

Purpose

Having goals, hopes and dreams, and a plan to achieve them.





Freedom

Having control of your life
and being heard in the
society.



Money

Having money to live a
good life and having
control over how it is
spent.



Home

Having a place that
belongs to you, where
you can control
everything that happens
there.



Help

Having good quality support that makes your skills and talents better, and makes sure that you have your rights, freedoms and responsibilities.



Life

Being an active part of the community, and adding value with your skills and talents.



Love

Having a range of loving relationships, such as family, partners and friends.
